Dear Alumni & Friends:

As we finish a challenging year, we take this opportunity to thank you, our generous alumni and friends, who have made a difference for so many individuals at The University of Maine. We heard numerous stories from students and faculty who would not have been able to further their education without your private support.

The effects of three years of a declining stock market have been felt campus-wide. The Foundation's pay-over to the University in FY'03 was \$3.3 million, \$300,000 less than the previous year. This decrease would have been greater had the Foundation not been able to allocate \$240,000 of unrestricted funds to help bridge the gap. As the average unmet financial need per student at the University continues to grow – currently \$1,453 – this reduced pay-over has had a significant impact on scholarship and program activities. In FY'04 we anticipate a University pay-over of \$2.1 million, which will result in \$652,000 less in scholarship funding.

During this difficult period the Foundation renewed its commitment to focus on our mission and long-term objective: seeking private support that provides the University with a margin of excellence for students and

faculty that just can't be accomplished through other funding. We readjusted our investment portfolio by reducing our operating expenses, by actively promoting an "Adopt-A-Student" campaign, and by asking donors to provide support to help offset the FY'04 shortfall.

Additionally, the Foundation's Audit & Policy Committee is reviewing our current spending policy of 5.75%, which is extremely high when compared to other universities and colleges. Balancing our current income needs against future needs is one of the most difficult issues our Foundation Board faces. Our objective is to provide a consistent stream of income to the University without jeopardizing future earnings. In order to maintain this intergenerational equity, the Committee has been asked to make a recommendation to the Board of Directors. Any changes to our current

policy would be phased in over a period of time so as to reduce any negative impact on the University.

This year we received 1,127 gifts totaling \$4 million. This is a significant decrease compared to our average of \$6.7 million and is a reflection of the weak economy and the decline in the stock market; however, the General Endowment Fund reported a return of 4.09%, with an average total return of 11.53% for the 10 years ending June 30, 2003. Our goal is to be in the top quartile of all college and university endowments.

Additionally, the Maine State Supreme Judicial Court determined that we should receive a portion of the Charles E. Gilbert Trust so that \$5.1 million will be used for “worthy and needy” students, as originally intended by the donor.

Our Board welcomed new members Don Collins of Caribou, Jon Dawson of Bangor, and Ellen Stinson of Standish. We thank our Board of Directors and members for their support. Their expertise and guidance helped us make decisions during a critical time.

Building private support to benefit our state university takes the combined effort, judgment, wisdom, and commitment of both our volunteer members and our dedicated Board.

Next year is the 70th anniversary of the University of Maine Foundation. We value the strong partnership we’ve established with University leadership over the years to build a better university. We especially want to acknowledge the leadership of President Peter Hoff, who has recognized the advantage of building private resources through the Foundation.

Again, we appreciate your support for The University of Maine. Your generosity provides a legacy ensuring a quality education for future generations of students and a stronger faculty.

The University of Maine Foundation manages more than 800 endowment funds totaling approximately \$77 million. The funds represent permanent assets invested to provide an important source of funding to benefit The University of Maine.

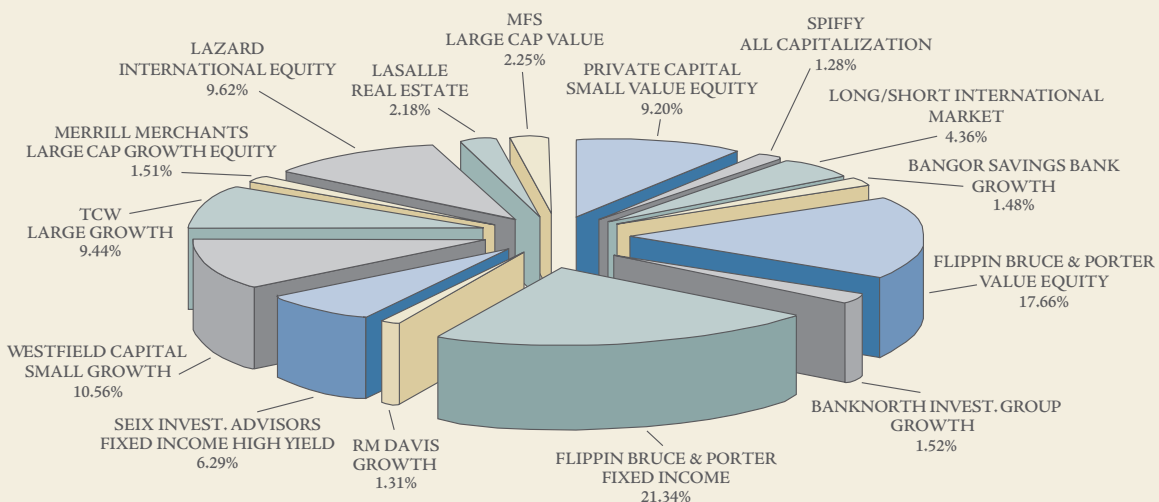
The General Endowment Fund operates on a total return basis, focusing on the overall return of the investment portfolio. The Foundation utilizes a spending policy of 5.75% of the three-year average market value of the fund. The Foundation Board of Directors approved this policy in 1995 in order to provide income consistency and dependability to the University and protect the endowment fund over the long term.

Additionally, a 5.75% spending policy suggests that a proportionally large amount of the endowment

earnings will be added to the endowment in times of high market growth, thus providing long-term growth in the funds. In periods when market growth is minimal, the 5.75% will provide a stable level of support to the current recipients of the endowment income.

The Foundation's Board of Directors and Investment Committee review this spending rate annually. Additionally, fourteen investment managers provide a diversified approach to the management of the investment portfolio of the General Endowment Fund.

investment managers as of June 30, 2003



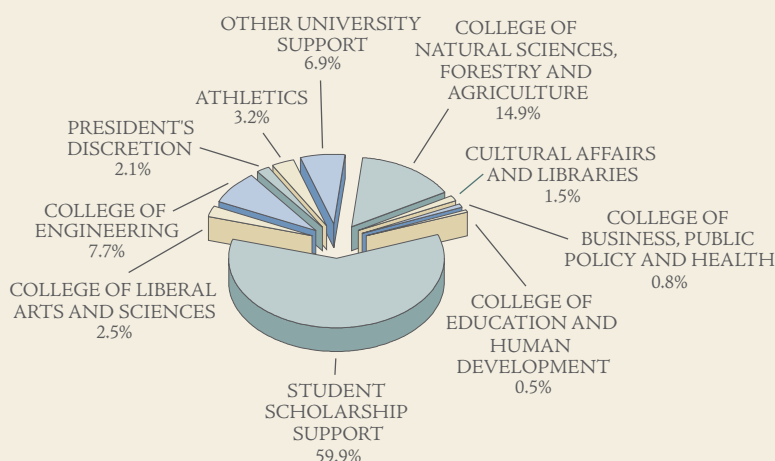

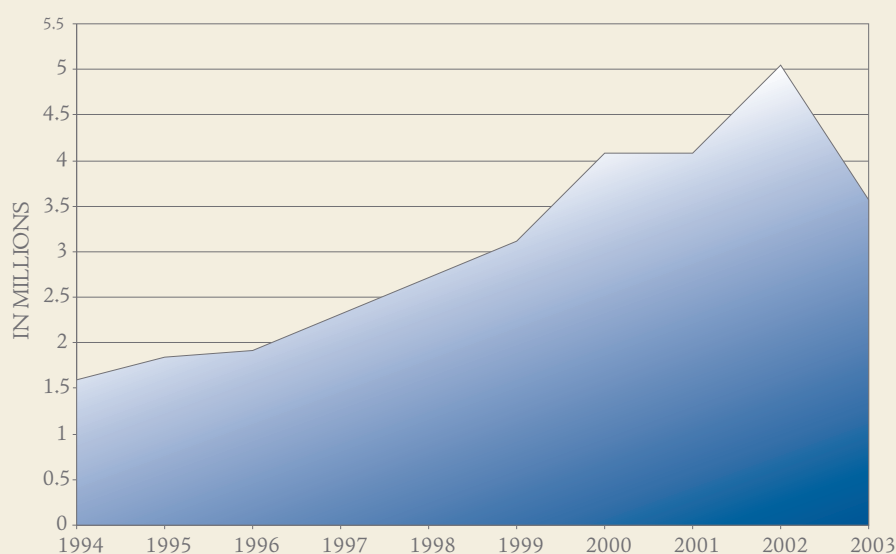

BARTLEY FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Jayne Bartley, together with her son Peter Newcomb Bartley, established this fund for scholarship assistance to Stearns High School graduates with financial need. A preference will be given to students majoring in Forestry or English. Jayne Bartley's husband, Hastings, was a member of the Class of 1947, Mrs. Bartley is a member of the Class of 1949, and Peter graduated from UMaine in 1979.

CAROL BOMBARD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Judith A. Whitney and Jean Whitney, two very good friends of Carol, a 1964 graduate of The University of Maine, established this fund. Carol taught advertising and journalism at the University and was dedicated to her students. A first preference will be given to students studying these disciplines.

HAZEL SWEETSER BOWEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Dr. Dawn S. Bowen '90G established this fund in honor of her mother-in-law, Hazel Sweetser Bowen, for her dedication to education. The fund will support a junior or senior majoring in Elementary or Secondary Education, who is a resident of Maine planning to teach in Maine.

PHILIP J. and MURIEL F. BROCKWAY '31, '32 SCHOLARSHIP*

This scholarship was established with gifts from colleagues, friends, and family in recognition of Mr. Brockway's loyal services to The University of Maine. Awards will be given to worthy students with financial need who are enrolled in a four-year curriculum.

CLASS OF 1957 SCHOLARSHIP*

The members of the Class of 1957 established this scholarship to provide aid to deserving students who demonstrate financial need and promise academic success. A preference shall be given to descendants of the Class of 1957 until the year 2032.

RICHARD R. and ANNE A. COLLINS SCHOLARSHIP

Richard and Anne Collins, members of the Classes of 1959 and 1961 respectively, established this scholarship to assist undergraduate students who are graduates of Wisdom High School in St. Agatha, Maine.

CPM CONSTRUCTORS SCHOLARSHIP

This fund was initiated at the request of Eldon Morrison '64, President of CPM Constructors, for undergraduates studying a discipline leading to the engineering or construction industry. Preferences include children of current CPM employees, Washington County high school graduates, and Phi Eta Kappa Fraternity members.

JAMES D. CROCKER FUND

Mr. Crocker established this fund with a bequest for purposes to be designated by the Foundation. Mr. Crocker was a dedicated and loyal alumnus of The University of Maine's Class of 1935.

CLARENCE ALBERT DAY '29H SCHOLARSHIP

Dorothy Day, a member of the Class of 1940, established this fund with a bequest in honor of her father, Clarence Day. A first preference will be given to students studying agriculture or a related field.

JOHN A. DeWILDE and NANCY CAMERON DeWILDE FUND

This scholarship was established by John DeWilde '54 and his wife Nancy DeWilde '55 for deserving full-time undergraduates pursuing a 4-year degree at any UM System institution. Residents of Union, Maine will receive first preference.

HENRY L. and CORA RUSSELL DOTEN SCHOLARSHIP*

This scholarship fund, initially established in 1962, will benefit undergraduates who have financial need and exemplary scholastic standing. Preference will be given to Civil Engineering, History or English majors.

HENRY FRANK DRUMMOND SCHOLARSHIP

Henry D. Meinecke '55 established this fund in honor of his grandfather, Henry Frank Drummond, a member of the Class of 1900. Mr. Drummond was the first in his family to attend college. After graduation he worked for a new electric company, General Electric, before assuming control of the family business, Bangor Box Company.

RAYMOND H. FOGLER LIBRARY ACQUISITION FUND

An anonymous donor established this fund for acquisitions for the Fogler Library. Both principal and income may be used at the discretion of the Dean of Cultural Affairs and Libraries.

CAROL MORTON FURET SCHOLARSHIP

Maralyn Morton Schoenberger established this fund in loving memory of her sister Carol, a talented painter. This award will assist students who show promise in the studio arts, especially painting and

drawing, to obtain their college education. Recipients must demonstrate financial need and talent. Preference will go to graduates of high schools in Maine's 2nd congressional district.

MARGARET GARDINER FORESTRY MANAGEMENT FUND

Mrs. Gardiner, a member of the Class of 1949, created this endowment to provide support for the operating and management costs of forestland given to the Green Endowment. In 1995 and 1999, Mrs. Gardiner donated several acres of forestland. It is her wish that this fund will help ensure a healthy wildlife population while allowing for recreational and other forest resource values.

JOE WARREN GERRITY '09 SCHOLARSHIP*

This fund was initially established with a gift from Joe Gerrity's wife, Margaret M. Gerrity, with ongoing contributions from their son, J. Frank Gerrity II. The income from this fund provides scholarship assistance to students who are enrolled at The University of Maine.

GORHAM SAVINGS BANK SCHOLARSHIP

Gorham Savings Bank established this fund to assist undergraduates at any of the UM System institutions. A first preference will benefit children of the Bank's current employees. A second preference will go to (1) students with financial need or (2) students with high academic standing from the Bank's service area.

LAWRENCE and MURIEL GRAHAM ALUMNI HOUSE FUND

Lawrence A. Graham, a member of the Class of 1944, and his wife Muriel established this fund through a charitable lead trust. The fund will provide perpetual support to Buchanan Alumni House for operational and maintenance expenses.

GEORGE R. GRAY '50 and NORMA M. GRAY '52 BUCHANAN PERENNIAL GARDEN FUND

Mr. and Mrs. Gray gave generously to Buchanan Alumni House with the naming of the perennial garden in the courtyard. In addition, the Grays established two

endowment funds, one for the general operation and maintenance of Buchanan Alumni House and a separate fund that will help maintain the perennial gardens on the premises.

GREAT FALLS SCHOLARSHIP

Jonathan LaBonte, a member of the Class of 2002, initiated this scholarship. The award will be given to an undergraduate student who is in at least his/her 2nd year and is maintaining a 3.0+ GPA. The recipient shall be a strong collaborator in student government and/or campus activities as well as a high school graduate or resident from the Lewiston/Auburn area.

CLARINE COFFIN GRENFELL '32 STUDENT POETRY PRIZE and POETRY SPEAKER FUND*

This fund was established by friends of Clarine Grenfell together with subsequent contributions by Mrs. Grenfell. The income shall be used by the Department of English to make annual awards to students having written the best poems. If earnings permit, the fund shall allow the Department to sponsor a notable poet to give a reading.

MATTHEW E. and RAMONA P. HIGHLANDS FOOD SCIENCE and HUMAN NUTRITION SCHOLARSHIP

and MATTHEW E. and RAMONA P. HIGHLANDS MATHEMATICS SCHOLARSHIP

Matthew E. Highlands, a Biology major who graduated in 1928, established these funds with a bequest in his name and that of his wife, Ramona, a Mathematics major who graduated in 1929. The scholarships will be given to deserving undergraduates on the basis of ability, character, financial need, and academic credentials, to a Food Science and Human Nutrition major, a Mathematics major, or a member of the Pi Chapter of Phi Mu Sorority, respectively.

ARTHUR ST. JOHN HILL FUND

William Brewer '64 and his wife Sandra established this fund in honor of Mr. Brewer's grandfather, a distinguished professor of Electrical Engineering at UMaine from 1918 to 1953. In 1964, the

Arthur St. John Hill Lecture Hall Wing was dedicated in his honor at Barrows Hall. This fund shall support technological improvements/enhancements to this wing.

GEORGE P. HITCHINGS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This fund was created with gifts from family and friends of Mr. Hitchings, valedictorian of the Class of 1937 and widely known as one of the top economists in the U. S. The scholarship is intended to benefit students who are most like him – Economics majors, letter winners in tennis and track, and Honors College participants.

THE HUMPHREY PaCEsetter SCHOLARSHIP

Dana Humphrey, Professor and Chair of the UM Civil and Environmental Engineering Department, and his wife Barbara established this scholarship to provide perpetual support to outstanding Civil Engineering majors. Recipients must demonstrate past academic achievement, commitment, and evidence of the pursuit of a career in civil engineering.

GEORGE L. JACOBSON, JR. QUATERNARY AND CLIMATE STUDIES FUND

George Jacobson, former Director of the Institute for Quaternary and Climate Studies, established this fund for the unrestricted support of the Institute, with a preference for Quaternary Paleoecology.

MARIE ROSE LABBÉ MEMORIAL FUND

Family and friends of Mrs. Labbé established this fund in her memory. The fund will support the Franco-American Centre at The University of Maine.

LAFAYETTE HOTELS- BLACK BEAR INN SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship was established by Lafayette Hotels and the Black Bear Inn to honor Dr. Suzanne Tyler, former Athletic Director at The University of Maine. The income from this fund will be given to a student athlete who is a resident of the state of Maine.

LAMBDA CHI ALPHA SCHOLARSHIP

The Beta Zeta Alumni Association of Lambda Chi Alpha Fraternity established this scholarship for deserving undergraduate students. Recipients must be members of the Lambda Chi Alpha Fraternity.

LUNDER SCHOLARS FUND

Peter and Paula Lunder established the Lunder Scholars Fund. A first preference will be given to former Dexter Shoe Company employees and their children. A second preference will be given to Maine residents in need of financial aid.

SMITH C. and CHARLENE W. MCINTIRE SCHOLARSHIP

Smith McIntire '32, a prominent agricultural leader from Aroostook County, and his wife Charlene established this award for Natural Sciences, Forestry and Agriculture students. A preference will be given to graduates of an Aroostook County high school or members of Alpha Gamma Rho Fraternity.

SANFORD and JOANNE MILLER MAINE CENTER for the ARTS FUND

Sanford "Sonny" Miller and his wife Joanne Miller '59, created this fund in recognition of the MCA's commitment to excellence, quality and diversity of programs. The fund will provide general operating and maintenance support, program enhancement, MCA marketing and outreach activities.

ROBERT W. NELSON MEMORIAL FUND

Mr. Nelson was a chemical engineering major who received a B.S. in 1945 and an M.S. in 1948 at UMaine. At the request of his family, donations from family and friends were given to establish this fund in his memory.

ANSEL ALVA PACKARD MEMORIAL FUND

Herbert Packard, a member of the Class of 1953, established this fund in memory of his father, Ansel Alva Packard, a graduate of the Class of 1916. The income from this fund will provide unrestricted support to the College of Engineering.

READING RECOVERY ENDOWMENT

This fund was created with gifts from friends and supporters of Reading Recovery. The income from this fund shall support the Reading Recovery Teacher Leader Trainer to ensure the long-term stability of this position.

JACQUELINE BEAU and DENNIS REZENDES HONORS COLLEGE FUND

Jacqueline and Dennis Rezendes '57 established this fund to promote excellence in UMaine's Honors College. The

fund will supplement the arts curriculum, support associates for mentoring Honors College students and for working with external constituents, and provide financial aid to out-of-state Honors College students who demonstrate academic merit.

ROGER W. and MABELLE ASHWORTH SMITH FUND

Relatives, friends and colleagues of Mabelle Ashworth Smith created this fund to remember Roger and Mabelle's love of Aroostook County and Presque Isle. The fund will provide scholarship assistance to 1) graduates of Presque Isle High School and 2) graduates of other Aroostook County high schools. Both Mr. and Mrs. Smith are graduates of the Class of 1937.

COLONEL ALBERT W. STEVENS ALUMNI HOUSE ENDOWMENT

Bobby A. Whitten established this fund in loving memory of her uncle, Colonel Albert W. Stevens. Colonel Stevens received his undergraduate degree at Maine in 1907 and his graduate degree in 1909. This fund will help operate and maintain Buchanan Alumni House.

DOMINICK F. SUSI II SCHOLARSHIP

Nick Susi was an active UM alumnus from the Class of 1972. Family, friends and colleagues established this scholarship in his memory. Recipients must have graduated from a Maine high school and must participate in the intercollegiate sport of men's basketball.

WALDO COUNTY SCHOLARSHIP

Dr. Albert P. Cox, a member of the Class of 1949, and his wife Estelle M. Cox established an annual award to undergraduates who demonstrate academic merit and financial need. A first preference will be given to graduates of Mt. View High School and a second preference to graduates of any Waldo County, Maine high school.

SCOTT and MARY-ELLEN WELDON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Scott Weldon was a graduate of the Class of 1952. Family, friends and colleagues established this fund as a tribute to both he and his wife, Mary-Ellen '52. Scholarships from this fund will be given to students demonstrating academic merit

who are studying Mechanical Engineering or Food Science and Human Nutrition.

DOROTHY CLARKE WILSON LIBRARY FUND

Dorothy Clarke Wilson was a distinguished author and an advocate for social justice. She established this fund with a bequest to provide support to maintain the Special Collections at the Fogler Library, including the Dorothy Clarke Wilson Collection.

The JOHN F. WILSON FUND

John Wilson '33 established this fund through a charitable gift annuity and donations in his memory. The intent of his fund is to provide financial assistance to the College of Engineering with a preference given in the area of management engineering.

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL DISCRETIONARY FUND

Friends and fans of the women's basketball program at UMaine established this fund to enhance the women's basketball program at the discretion of the head coach.

WOODARD & CURRAN EMPLOYEE SCHOLARSHIP*

This fund was established with gifts from Woodard and Curran and its employees for student scholarship assistance. The order of preference is (1) children of Woodard & Curran employees; (2) Civil Engineering and/or Environmental Sciences majors; and (3) deserving students who demonstrate financial need.

WILLIAM P. ZOIDIS SCHOLARSHIP

Friends, family and colleagues of William Zoidis '54 established this scholarship in honor of his retirement and the closing of the family restaurant, Pilot's Grill, the site of historical events in the Bangor community for many years. The award will benefit undergraduate students with a preference to History majors or those participating in intercollegiate athletic programs.

Established by friends of the MCA, this fund will be used to make performing arts accessible to young people in northern, eastern and central Maine — especially young students—and to help teachers integrate performing arts into their curricula.

Dr. Kathryn E. Slott, Associate Professor of French, established this fund in loving memory of her parents. The fund is to be used at the discretion of the head coach for women's basketball for the team's summer school program.

STUDENT GOVERNMENT LEADERSHIP AWARD

The UMaine Student Government established this fund to provide one or more awards to students involved in campus leadership efforts. Recipients shall not be limited to those involved in student government.

UNIVERSITY of MAINE COMMUNITY POLICING FUND

A group of people interested in the UMaine community established this fund for the benefit of public safety, including support of The University of Maine's mounted police program.

LEONARD BENJAMIN WOODBREY/UNIVERSITY SINGERS FUND

Eva Woodbrey Lekachman, a member of the Class of 1944, established this fund in memory of her brother Leonard Benjamin Woodbrey (1926-1937). This fund supported the production of 1,000 CDs to be used by the University Singers for recruitment and promotion of The University of Maine.

HERBERT WOODBREY ADOPT-A-STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

This fund was created by Eva Woodbrey Lekachman '44 in honor of her brother Herbert Woodbrey. This fund will provide ten one-time scholarships to students in need of financial assistance.
