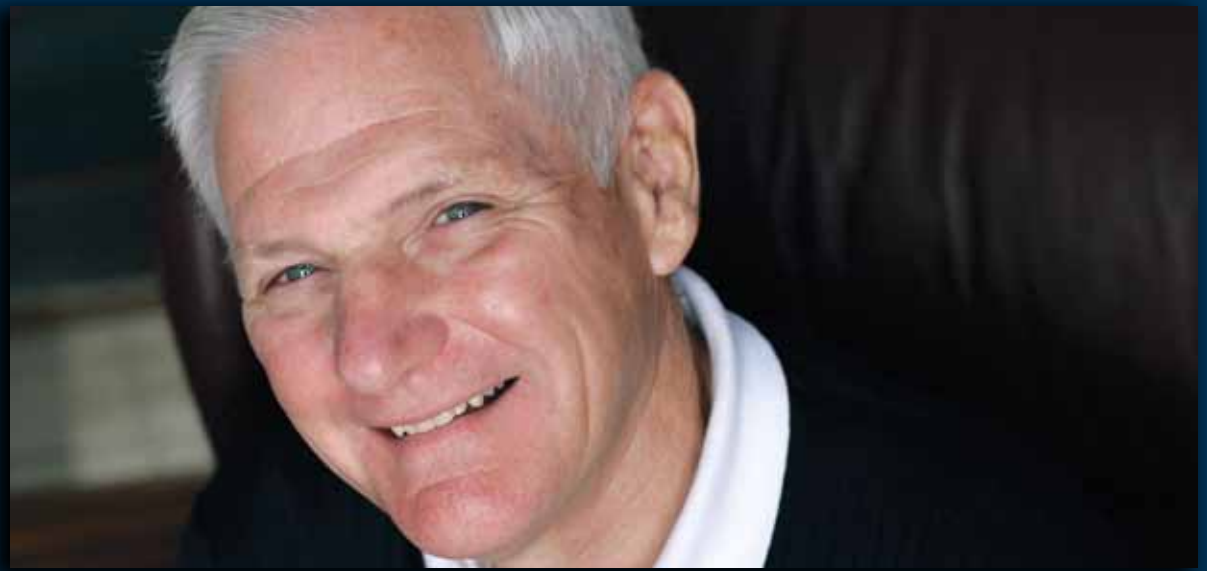

What size fund provides a meaningful scholarship? An endowed scholarship of \$20,000 could generate \$1000 in annual earnings, which is equivalent to only 4.5%¹ of an in-state student's total educational costs. Today's students face higher costs each year and overwhelming debt. ¹2010-2011 estimated in-state student budget is \$22,134

How will my fund keep up with the real rate of educational inflation at UMaine?



Our minimum investment goal is an absolute return of 10%. Our spending policy averages 5.5% and total fees are 2%. The difference is returned to build the principal to offset the ravages of inflation. Endowments should maintain their purchasing power over time.


This year, the Foundation experienced slow but steady recovery, with assets of \$157.6 million. The investment return was 11.1%. Last year, assets totaled \$149 million. During 2010, we processed 1,760 new gifts totaling \$5,387,222. The Foundation also holds 1,305 funds, an increase of 72 over 2009. Forty of these new funds were created as the result of the Foundation's 75th Anniversary matching gift program. This program helped establish new named scholarship endowments for the University, and as they grow, they'll provide valuable assistance to our students for years to come.

The current recession is making it more difficult than ever. Tuition at Maine's land grant university was recently increased by 5.5 percent. This means that an in-state student will pay \$10,142 for tuition in 2010-2011— that's more than 25 times the \$400 annual tuition paid by in-state students in 1960.

Your continued support is vital and greatly appreciated. As always, we strive to be accountable to you and the students depending on all of us.

Your gift to the University of Maine Foundation is the gift of a lifetime and an investment in the future.

Since 1934, the University of Maine Foundation's role in supporting the University of Maine has been perpetuated by many alumni and friends who, through their generosity, share a common interest in strengthening the teaching, research and service mission of Maine's land-grant university.

The University of Maine Foundation specializes in planned gifts that include bequests, trusts and other life income plans. Planned giving is a unique philanthropic tool that allows you to support the University of Maine's continued excellence while also fulfilling your own financial objectives. Planned gifts often have attractive tax benefits associated with them and can allow you to leave a legacy without diminishing assets during your lifetime.

A variety of assets can be used to establish a planned gift. From cash to real estate to tangible personal property, the Foundation staff is ready to assist you and your advisors to find the best fit for your personal circumstances.

Perhaps the most common form of a planned gift is through a bequest. If you wish to leave the University of Maine Foundation a bequest in your will or trust for a scholarship or some other purpose, you can amend your will or trust to reflect your wishes.

The following represents sample language for doing so.

"I give and bequeath to the University of Maine Foundation for the University of Maine (possible choices below)

- the sum of \$ _____; or
- _____ percent of my estate; or
- the property described herein to establish (or benefit if already existing) the _____ Fund. The principal of said Fund is to be endowed and only the income earned on the principal shall be used to provide financial assistance."

For those individuals that have additional charitable interests outside the University of Maine, the Foundation will help you establish a donor-advised fund. This is a cost-effective alternative to a private family foundation and allows you to consolidate and manage all of your charitable giving.

Planned gifts change the lives of the donors who make them and the students who benefit from them. Your support will enable students of every background and ambition at the University of Maine, from first-generation college enrollees to dedicated graduate researchers, to reach their goal while continuing to make the University of Maine a leader in higher education.

The General Endowment Fund of the University of Maine Foundation is a pool of over 1300 permanently endowed, quasi-endowed and prudent expenditure allowance funds.

The Foundation's objective in managing its endowed funds is to generate an income stream for distribution to the University and provide for adequate growth in the endowments. To facilitate the achievement of these goals, the Foundation operates the General Endowment Fund on a total return basis, which focuses on the overall return of the investment portfolio including both investment income (interest and dividends) and capital appreciation (realized and unrealized.) Under the total return basis, an endowment spending rate of the invested assets is established versus only spending from interest and dividend income.

The Foundation's spending rate, as established by its board of directors, is 5.5% of the six-year average fair-market value of the investment pool. To provide for the accumulation of earnings, only endowment funds that have been in the General Endowment at least one year will be eligible for spending.

For permanent endowments, spending is contingent upon the fund accumulating sufficient earnings to support the calculated spending amount. The Uniform Prudent Management of Institutional Funds Act (UPMIFA) was enacted in 2009. Under this act, donors who created funds after July 1, 2009 have the option of a prudent expenditure allowance in which the donor may direct that the principal be invaded for distribution for the uses, benefits, purposes and duration for which the Fund was established.

The Foundation Board of Directors believes that the donors who established endowed funds with the Foundation intended to create funds according to the dictionary definition of endowment, meaning that the principal of the fund would not be invaded for distribution. Thus, funds endowed in the Foundation before July 1, 2009 will not be expended if the fund's value is less than its historic dollar value, in accordance with the Foundation's spending policy unless the original donor(s) desire to comply with UPMIFA.

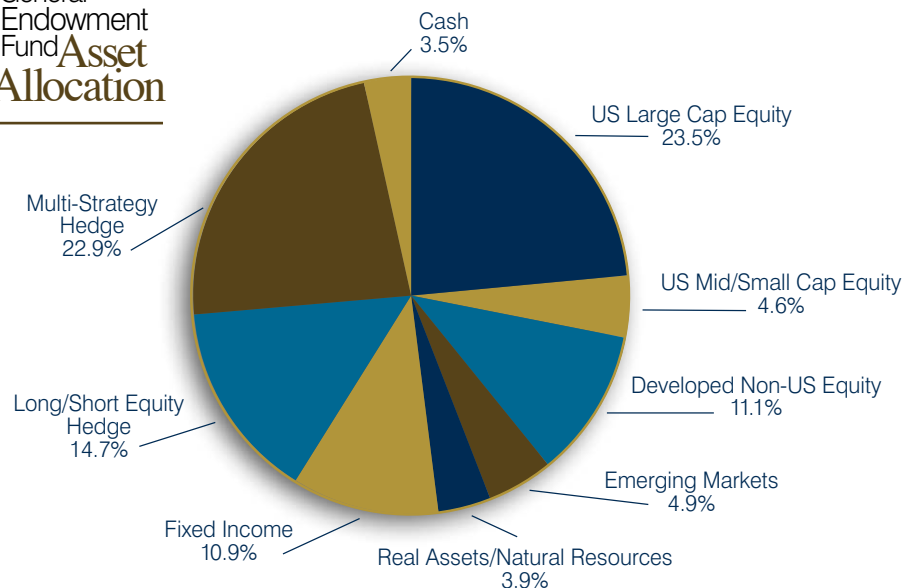

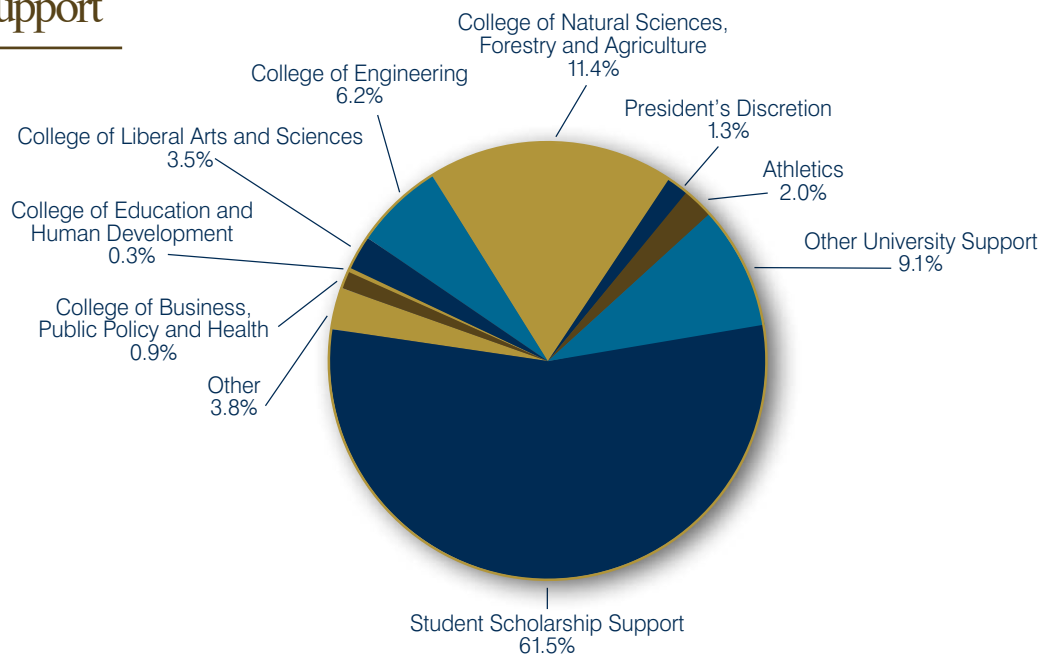

Robert I. Anderson '64 and Jacqueline Towle Anderson '64 Scholarship

Bob '64 and Jackie Towle Anderson '64 established this fund for undergraduate students enrolled in engineering, mathematics or music, who demonstrate strong academic potential. Preference shall be given to students from Aroostook County, Maine or Monroe County, New York. Bob and Jackie had distinguished careers with Eastman Kodak.

Arbour Fox PaCEsetter Scholarship

Richard and Patricia Fox established this fund for outstanding civil engineering students. In 1968, Patricia Arbour Fox received her B.A. in French. Dick received his B.S. and M.S. in civil engineering in 1968 and 1970, respectively; he also received a J.D. from Suffolk University in 1979.

Dr. John H. and Mabel Ashworth Scholarship

This fund was established by Mabelle Ashworth Smith, a member of the Class of 1937, in honor of her parents. Dr. Ashworth taught economics and sociology at UMaine from 1919 to 1940. Both he and Mrs. Ashworth were devoted to family and leaders in their community. Awards will be given to graduates of Aroostook County high schools, preferably Presque Isle High School.

David M. Austin Fund

This fund was established by Mr. Austin and his wife Kelly, members of the classes of 1990 and 2006, respectively. Exact details of how the fund will be used have not yet been determined.

Bangor High School Aspirations Scholarship

An anonymous donor established this scholarship to encourage a sophomore at Bangor High School to consider pursuing a post-secondary education.

Dr. Richard F. Barter Scholarship

Richard Barter, a member of the Class of 1958, established this fund to assist Maine students from rural areas. Dr. Barter spent his professional career holding headmaster positions in schools in several states, after receiving his Masters and his Ph.D. from Johns Hopkins University in 1959 and 1962, respectively.

Dr. David J. Batuski Excellence Fund for Physics Education

This fund was established by Colby Chandler, former CEO of Eastman Kodak Corporation and a member of the class of 1950 and his wife Jean in honor of Dr. Batuski. The fund will support student travel and outreach to encourage young people to explore careers in engineering and the sciences.

Priscilla Hardy Bennett '43 Music Scholarship

Malcolm D. Hardy '44 established this fund in memory of his sister, Priscilla Hardy Bennett, a member of the Class of 1943. The fund will provide scholarship aid for deserving undergraduate students who are majoring in music.

Janet Marston '55 and William "Brother Bill" Bodwell '50 Scholarship

Janet and Bill Bodwell, members of the Class of 1955 and 1950, respectively, established this fund for Maine students. The scholarship will alternate between food science and human nutrition majors and members of the University Band.

William R. Bodwell Civil Engineering Scholarship

Russell & Barbara Bodwell, '44 and '45 established this fund in honor of their son William, a member of the Class of 1975. The fund will assist deserving civil engineering graduate students who demonstrate academic merit.

John C. and Charlene R. Bridge Honors College Fund

John Bridge, a member of the Class of '57, '63G and his wife Charlene established this fund. Mr. Bridge served for more than 30 years as President and CEO of the family business, Bridgecorp. Both John and Charlene were very active in their community. This fund will provide general financial assistance for the Honors College.

Richard M. Burrill '44 Memorial Fund

Family and friends of Richard Burrill, an engineering major from the Class of 1944 who passed away in March, established this fund for mechanical engineering students.

Frank and Helene Crohn Edna St. Vincent Millay Prize

Mr. and Mrs. Crohn established this poetry prize in honor of one of Maine's best loved poets, Edna St. Vincent Millay. The prize is awarded through the National Poetry Foundation at the University of Maine as a way to recognize and reward the accomplishments of the talented poets who attend the Master's Program in English.

John M. Condon Forestry Scholarship

John Condon '74 established this fund for forestry students, preferably graduates of Maine high schools in their second, third, or fourth years.

Dr. Anthony B. and Mary G. Cristo Scholarship

Dr. Cristo, a member of the Class of 1949 who passed away in 2009, established this scholarship through a bequest. Recipients must demonstrate high academic standing and financial need.

Robert (Bob) DeBoo Scholarship

Dr. DeBoo, a member of the Class of 1962, established this fund to provide financial support to students pursuing a M.S. or Ph.D. in the area of applied forest entomology. Preference shall be given to applicants expressing an interest in working in and/or contributing to improved forest management in Maine.

Albert A. DiMillo, Jr. Accounting Scholarship

This fund was established by Mr. DiMillo, a member of the Class of 1976, to assist third or fourth year accounting majors in high academic standing who demonstrate financial need.

E. James & Eileen Ferland Engineering Excellence Scholarship

This scholarship was established by Jim Ferland '64 and his wife Eileen to encourage bright men and women to consider majoring in engineering and to apply their talent to solving society's challenging problems. A preference will be given to students from Skowhegan High School.

Joanne Bodwell Ferreira Civil Engineering Scholarship

Russell & Barbara Bodwell, '44 and '45 established this fund in honor of their daughter Joanne, a member of the Class of 1973. The fund will assist deserving civil engineering undergraduate students who demonstrate academic merit.

Michael I. Flaherty '72 and Ellen Pratt Flaherty '71 Fund

Mr. and Mrs. Flaherty established this fund for two purposes: to assist physics majors in excellent academic standing, and to provide support for the Fogler Library.

Beatrice P. Flaherty Scholarship

Michael and Ellen Flaherty established this fund in memory of Michael's mother, Beatrice. The fund will provide aid for deserving undergraduates majoring in physics.

Virgil E. Flaherty Scholarship

Michael and Ellen Flaherty established this fund in memory of Michael's father, Virgil. The fund will provide aid for deserving undergraduates majoring in physics.

Robert and Sharon Fuehrer Library Scholarship

Robert '57 and Sharon Ward Fuehrer '60 created this scholarship for students with financial need, preferably from Vermont. The intent is to assist students who have an interest in, volunteer at, or work in the Fogler Library.

Robert C. and Sharon W. Fuehrer Scholarship

Robert '57 and Sharon Ward Fuehrer '60 created this scholarship for students with financial need majoring in child development and family relations or food science and human nutrition. Recipients must be graduates of a Maine high school, preferably from Aroostook County.

French Graduate Student International Study Scholarship

Dr. Kathryn E. Slott, Associate Professor of French, established this fund for deserving Master of Arts in French or Master of Arts in Teaching French graduate students who are studying in France or in Quebec Province while paying tuition either at the University of Maine or at an institution in France or Quebec Province.

John K. Gallant '89 Fund

Mr. Gallant, a member of the Class of 1989, established this fund for scholarship support for University of Maine students. The specific details of how the fund will be used have not been decided.

Margaret Gardiner School of Forest Resources Fund

This fund was established with proceeds from land donated by Margaret Gardiner, a member of the Class of 1949. The fund will provide general support to the School of Forest Resources.

Margaret Gardiner Woodlands Operation Fund

This fund was established with proceeds from land donated by Margaret Gardiner, a member of the Class of 1949. The fund will support the operation and management costs of woodlands given under the Green Endowment Program.

Andrew Gerke Memorial Sigma Phi Epsilon Scholarship

The family, friends and Sigma Phi Epsilon brothers of Andrew Gerke established this scholarship for deserving fraternity brothers in his honor with the hope to inspire recipients to give in return. Andrew was an incredible young man who was involved in numerous musical and humanitarian organizations. He lost his life in 2009 while a student at UMaine.

George S. Ginsberg Memorial Fund

Harvey S. Ginsberg established this fund with a bequest in honor of his father, George S. Ginsberg. George earned his B.A. degree in economics in 1921. He was the captain of the football team, a member of the Senior Skull Society, and the recipient of both Block M and Black Bear awards. Recipients must be members of the football team who demonstrate the highest standards of sportsmanship and dedication.

Judson "Bud" and Bette Grant Football Scholarship

Mr. and Mrs. Grant, together with their children, created this scholarship to provide scholarship aid for a deserving undergraduate football student athlete who has demonstrated financial need and is a graduate of a Maine high school.

Basil and Harriett Heanssler Lobster Institute Fund

Basil and Harriett Heanssler, active members of the Lobster Pound Owners Association who have been involved in the industry for over 70 years, created this fund to help sustain both the lobster resource and a viable lobster fishery through conservation, outreach, research and education.

Richard C. Hill and Elizabeth C. Hill Family Fund

Dick Hill, Director Emeritus of the Department of Industrial Cooperation and Professor Emeritus of Mechanical Engineering, established this fund with a charitable remainder unitrust. The fund will support five areas on campus: Collins Center for the Arts, College of Engineering, Honors College, Division of Music, and Department of the Industrial Cooperation.

Kenneth Clark Jordan '44 Scholarship

This fund was established by Richard Innes, a member of the Class of 1944, and his wife Rachel in honor of Richard's classmate. Jordan and a fellow researcher built the first operating model of a practical atomic battery, patented in 1958. Recipients must be students majoring in physics, engineering physics, or astronomy who are in good academic standing.

Keep Maine Unique Sustainability Scholarship

Douglas DeAngelis received his B.S. degree in electrical engineering from UMaine in 1988 and completed his M.S. from MIT in 2006. The fund will provide scholarships for students working on research on sustainable development solutions that identify and help implement improved land use planning.

President Robert A. Kennedy Senior Alumni Scholarship

University of Maine senior alumni established this fund in appreciation and in honor of UMaine's 18th president, Robert Kennedy. The earnings will benefit students through the Senior Alumni Scholarship Fund.

Jane Stinchfield Knapp Scholarship

Jane Stinchfield Knapp attained her undergraduate degree from Colby College and her M. Ed. degree from UMaine in 1971. She taught biology for many years and is serving in the Maine House of Representatives. Scholarship recipients must be graduates of Maine high schools majoring in biology with plans for becoming a biology teacher.

Patrice M. Krant Travel Scholarship

Patrice Krant, a member of the Class of 1978, established this fund for deserving students who have demonstrated financial need, who are graduates of Maine high schools, and students within the Maine Business School. The purpose of the fund is to afford students an opportunity to participate in national and international academic related travel.

Doris Dow Ladd Scholarship

Betty J. Ladd, a member of the Class of 1950, established this fund in loving memory of her parents, Doris and Harland, both members of the Class of 1925. Doris's lifelong work was in extension and Harland's was in education. This fund will assist graduate students pursuing a career in extension.

Helen "Penny" Mitchell Lehman Social Work Fund

Family and friends established this fund in memory of Penny Lehman, a member of the Class of 1962, who passed away this year. Penny's career was devoted to helping people through social services and this fund will assist those who show promise in the social work field.

Dr. Waldo "Mac" Libbey '44 Swim Program Fund

Dr. Libbey taught in the Electrical and Computer Engineering Department for 47 years, specializing in acoustics and he applied his research to noise control and hearing protection. This fund will support the varsity swim program.

Anne C. Lucey Fund

This fund was established by Anne Lucey, a member of the Class of 1981 who received a law degree from the University of Maine School of Law in 1991. Exact details on how the fund will be used have not yet been determined.

Matthew & Esther McNeary Scholarship

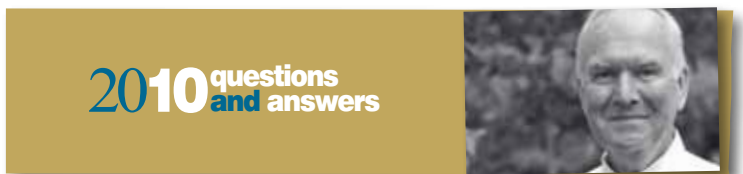
